

On September 17th, Cambium Networks Limited - in administration ("Cambium Networks") published a statement regarding our status in Administration and the disposition of the business. This letter is an update to the originally published document.

Cambium Networks is the main trading entity of the Cambium Group, which designs, produces, and sells wireless telecommunications equipment, including fixed wireless broadband solutions, enterprise-class Wi-Fi, switches, and security solutions, and defense network radios.

David Shambrook, Gordon Thomson, Joe Barry and James Woodhead of RSM UK Restructuring Advisory LLP were appointed Joint Administrators of Cambium Networks Limited (UK entity only) on 14 September 2026.

On September 22, 2026, Cambium Networks and Airspan Communications Limited, a company incorporated in England and Wales ("Airspan"), entered into a Business Sale Agreement (the "Business Sale Agreement") pursuant to which Cambium Networks sold to Airspan the business and assets relating to the Company's defense business and certain fixed broadband product lines (collectively, the "Business"), and Cambium Networks, Inc. concurrently entered into a bill of sale to transfer certain U.S. related Business assets to Airspan Networks Inc.. The acquired product portfolio includes the PMP 450 platform, PTP 670, PTP 450i, PTP 700, 28 and 60 GHz cnWave, and cnReach. The management system and planning software for the acquired portfolio, including LINKPlanner, cnHeat, and cnMaestro as it relates to the referenced products, are included in the Business Sale Agreement.

The Joint Administrators are actively progressing several potential going-concern transactions for the remaining business units of Cambium Networks and will provide additional updates as appropriate.

In conjunction with those efforts, Cambium Networks is extending support of cnMaestro Cloud through at least October 2026, including support of the entire enterprise product portfolio. Cambium Networks' objective is to find an acquiror for CN Maestro to ensure long-term access or, alternatively, allow the ability to transition from a cloud environment to an on-premises implementation deployment.

Regarding Network Service Edge (NSE), while cnMaestro Cloud support is extended, Cambium Networks is also advancing an on-premises implementation of NSE and expects to release it to the existing user community in the coming days.
