

Cambium Networks Limited in administration (“Cambium Networks”) is the main trading entity of the Cambium Group, which designs, produces, and sells wireless telecommunications equipment, including fixed wireless broadband solutions, enterprise-class Wi-Fi, switches, and security solutions, and defense network radios.

The group faced challenging trading conditions due to material supply chain disruption and increased costs over recent years, which triggered cash flow pressure.

David Shambrook, Gordon Thomson, Joe Barry and James Woodhead of RSM UK Restructuring Advisory LLP were appointed Joint Administrators of Cambium Networks Limited (UK entity only) on 14 September 2026.

The Joint Administrators are actively progressing a number of potential going concern transactions.

Cambium Networks understands this news comes as a shock to its customers and partners, each with deep concerns about their networks and businesses. Additional communications are being prepared to address those concerns, particularly with regard to ongoing cnMaestro™ availability. The intention is that cnMaestro Cloud will continue to operate at least through 1 October.

At this point, it is anticipated that the fixed wireless broadband business will largely resume after a relatively short pause. Production has been discontinued of Wi-Fi access points, NSE devices, and cnMatrix™ switches. Finished goods inventory of Wi-Fi access points, NSE devices, and cnMatrix switches remains with Cambium Networks, its Distributors, and in some cases in transit; as does inventory of Fixed Wireless Broadband equipment. At this time, Distributors may sell existing finished goods inventory at their discretion. Cambium Networks expects to make any existing inventory of finished products available in the coming days for sale via the Administration.

Cambium Networks recognizes and appreciates the shock and situation our customers and partners have been placed in. Cambium Networks will work to provide additional communication and direction in the coming days.
